Full description of the request

Request:

We respectfully request an extension of the 'chapter 7' waiver for the front and rear axles and suspension that was originally granted for the first event of the 2012 WTCC at Monza (TC-R028) and the second event in Valencia (TC-R037). We kindly ask for an extension for third event in Marrakech and a reduction of the extra ballast from 30kg to 15kg due to the improvements we have made by now.

Reason:

Due to the large amount of work required to re-design, manufacture and test the new components required for the FIA to grant homologation, we require a waiver to run the existing non-approved parts for the next race event.

Ford and Team AON are still working very closely with the FIA technical department in order to produce parts that will be deemed acceptable within a realistic timescale:

- Reworked front and rear subframes were already approved and will be fitted to the Team AON race cars from the Valencia onwards as well as a revised rear camber link
- Schemes of other affected parts were submitted and await approval
